

10 THINGS you should know about the eVisa Application system of the Republic of Moldova

What types of eVisa could be obtained online:

Only the short-term visa (**C visa type**) can be obtained online. Applicants for other visa categories should contact one of the diplomatic missions or consular offices of the Republic of Moldova abroad.

What is an eVisa and how can I apply:

An eVisa is an authorization/permit (issued in the PDF format) to enter the territory of the Republic of Moldova. An eVisa grants the same right to enter Moldovan territory as an ordinary sticker visa in the passport. In order to apply for an eVisa, foreign citizens should access the Government web portal www.evisa.gov.md.

The short-term eVisa can be requested for the following purposes:

- business
- tourism
- visits of relatives/friends
- sports activities
- cultural, humanitarian, scientific activities

Who examines eVisa applications for the Republic of Moldova:

The General Directorate of Consular Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and European Integration of the Republic of Moldova in cooperation with other relevant authorities.

The facilitation granted by applying for the eVisa:

The only facilitation granted by the eVisa consists in the online application, without the personal presence of the applicant at the **Embassy / Consulate of the Republic of Moldova**. Foreigners who come from the states that must present an invitation issued by the **Bureau for Migration and Asylum** are not exempt from presenting this document while applying for the eVisa.

What is the fee for an eVisa:

The eVisa fee is 80 Euros.

The term of examination of the eVisa request:

The examination period of the electronic visa application is up to **10 calendar days** from the date of application; the term may be extended if necessary up to **20 days**.

Method of payment:

After completing the application for the eVisa, the applicant can make the payment by credit or debit card (e.g., Visa, MasterCard, etc.).

Necessary documents that the foreigner should present while crossing the border:

- a printed eVisa
- a travel document
- a copy of the invitation as well as other supporting documents according the purpose of the visit
- health insurance for the period of stay in the **Republic of Moldova**.

How do I know the result of the eVisa request:

In the legally designated time, the applicant will be notified via **e-mail** about the outcome of the application review. In case of approval, the applicant will receive an eVisa in PDF format.
